PROGRAM TIMELINE NOMINATED


The City of El Paso was selected to participate in the Aspen Institute Latinos and Society's first cohort of cities to be part of the Latino Business and Entrepreneurship Initiative. The initiative convened local entrepreneurial support organizations to coalesce around strategic priorities and implement solutions to boost and sustain the local business economy. Cross-sector leaders recommended the launch of a centralized business center to navigate all the resources available through non-profit organizations. Place-based intervention not only caters to our small business community, but it also strengthens the business ecosystem.
